


refers to the six countries Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Serbia. The region is at the centre of the efforts of a European integration process, and several projects are currently preparing the countries for future EU accession.

Since 2012, Swiss, Austrian, German and US american development agencies and UNDP invested more than **EUR 1,5** billion in over **350** projects in the Western Balkans. In addition, as part of the Instrument for Pre-Accession (IPA) the European Union provided around **EUR 4.2** billion during the past six years. Overall, the mentioned agencies invested more than **EUR 6** billion in the following main sectors:



Funding Volume in the Western Balkans

European Development Agencies and the EU supported with almost EUR 700 million inter-regional projects in the Western Balkan. Most national projects are financed in Serbia and Kosovo with EUR 2,1 billion and EUR 890 million each. Broken down to the population of the six Western Balkan countries, however, Kosovo and Montenegro received the majority of the funding with respectively around EUR 480 and EUR 430 per capita over the past years. In total, over the past six years, at least EUR 2.100 were invested per capita in the Western Balkans:




Chamber Partnership Western Balkans
